

Milton American Baseball - Scholarship Guidelines

Overview

This scholarship is for graduating seniors who have represented dedication, passion and sportsmanship for Milton American Baseball over their years in the program.

Qualifications

Milton American Baseball (MAB) will be sponsoring two (2) \$500 scholarships. (1) one will be awarded to a Milton High School graduate. The second scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from another high school or another MHS graduate. Scholarship candidates will have participated in the MAB program for a minimum of three years, including their 12-year-old season. Candidate must be planning to continue their education at a vocational school or college or university (two-year or four-year) or has enlisted in a branch of the US Armed Forces. These scholarships are one-time grants, designated to assist students pursuing further education.

Applicant Requirements To be eligible for consideration you must:

- ✓ Be scheduled to graduate this year (Class of 2023)
- ✓ Participated, a minimum of three (3) years in MAB, including their 12-year-old season.

Application

Submit a brief essay describing how playing Milton American Baseball prepared you to succeed in High School and for your future. Please indicate what you gained from being part of a team, or from volunteering for MAB, or other local organizations. Please keep it to a maximum of 600 words.

Applications are due via email to info@miltonamericanbaseball.org by Friday, May 19th. When emailing the application, the application must include the Personal Information, signed Statement of Understanding by both the Applicant and a Parent or Guardian found on page two of this document, and your brief essay about how MAB influenced you as requested above.

Applicants will be checked to confirm league participation. The MAB Scholarship Committee will be comprised of MAB Board Members and winners will be chosen by a vote among the committee. Winners will be notified, and the awards will be presented at the school's awards banquet. This award is not being presented to the most accomplished athlete or the most prolific student, nor is the scholarship awarded on a need basis, but to those individuals that dedicated themselves to Milton American Baseball.
